## Maker of the Home/ Keepers of the Home/ Busy at Home/ Manager of the Home

Titus 2:4-5 So that they may encourage the young women to tenderly love their husbands and their children, to be sensible, pure, makers of a home [where God is honored], good-natured, being subject to their own husbands, so that the word of God will not be dishonored. AMP

Titus 2:5b... Then they will not bring shame on the word of God. NLT

## The impact of a mother's teachings

Proverbs 1:8-9 Listen, my son, to your father's instruction and do not forsake your mother's teaching. They are a garland to grace your head and a pendants to adorn your neck. NIV

Proverbs 2:1-6, 9-15 My son, if you receive my words and treasure up my commandments with you...discretion will watch over you, understanding will guard you, delivering you from the way of evil. ESV

Proverbs 3:1-2 My son, do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments, for length of days and years of life and peace they will add to you. ESV

Proverbs 6:20-23 My son, keep your father's commands and do not forsake your mother's teaching. Bind them upon your heart forever; fasten them around your neck. ## **A mother teaching her children to obey and honor their parents**

Ephesians 6:1-4 Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right. “Honor your father and mother”—which is the first commandment with a promise— “that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.” Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger, but bring them up in the discipline and instruction of the Lord. NIV84
